

All vendors must comply with the following rules. Careful attention is directed to booth decor and costume guidelines.
Full compliance with all rules is required.

- SPACE DECOR AND MAINTENANCE** – All Food Vendors must be self-contained within the space provided. All booths must be decorated in an Irish theme. All signage must be professional and fit the theme of the Irish Fair – signs on brown cardboard are never acceptable. Every food vendor space must have a sign hanging at the front top of the booth to identify it. This sign must be AT LEAST 1' by 4'. A similar sign is required showing foods sold and prices. Cardboard boxes, storage and packing boxes or crates must not be visible to the public and trash and empty boxes must be removed periodically and dumped in the main trash bin – NOT the receptacles placed for use by the public. Food Vendors are responsible for keeping clean the public area surrounding the exterior of their space from general trash and debris at all times.
- EMPLOYEE OUTFIT GUIDELINES** – All food vendors, their employees, assistants, and anyone inside the booth must be appropriately dressed during all public hours of the event. Jeans, shorts and t-shirts are NOT ACCEPTABLE.
- T-shirts and similar items and non-food merchandize may not be sold** by any food vendor without the written permission of the Foundation President and then only if such items contain the name and logo of the Food Vendor.
- FOOD SERVICE HOURS** –All Food Services must be open and ready for business at 10 a.m. each day, and may not close before 7:00 p.m.
- EMPLOYEE PASSES** – Each Food Vendor will be given appropriate employee passes for use during the event; Each Food vendor will receive appropriate delivery pass for setup purposes.
- ELECTRICITY** is **not** provided. Vendors must provide their own electricity and their own heavy duty extension cords.
- VENDOR DOUBLING UP** (sharing a booth) is not allowed without prior written permission of the Irish Fair Foundation. When allowed, there will be an additional fee. Doubling without permission will result in a double fee.
- EQUIPMENT RENTAL** – Tables, chairs, supplies and equipment are not provided. Vendors may rent tables, chairs and other equipment (tablecloths, skirts) by contacting **AMERICAN RENT ALL at 818-345-4102 or 800-540-4102.**
- ALCOHOL-NOT PERMITTED:** Food Vendors are not permitted to sell or dispense alcohol beverages of any kind.
- SODA BEVERAGE AND BOTTLED WATER MAY BE SOLD BY FOOD VENDORS:** Food Vendors are permitted a non-exclusive right to sell soda beverages, bottled water and coffee, tea and chocolate beverages.
- CITY OF IRVINE BUSINESS LICENSE FEE** of \$25 must be added to the Check payable to the IFF or Vendor may submit a copy of their current City of Irvine Business License.

SETUP/TAKEDOWN

Friday	1:00 – 7:00 p.m.

Sunday takedown	7:30 – 9 p.m.

All Vendor non-stationary vehicles must be removed by the end of setup time, and will be allowed on grounds Sunday night for takedown as soon as foot traffic is light.

ORANGE COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT REQUIREMENTS

Food Vendors must comply with all, and pay all fees, Orange County Health Department Requirements. Contact County of Orange Health Care Agency Environmental Health Services – Mr. David Shepas 714-433-6177 between 7:00 am and 8:30 am, Monday through Friday for further Information and assistance.

DAYS AND HOURS

Public hours are Saturday and Sunday 10:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Vendor areas are secured and guarded, and gates are locked during all non-selling hours, including overnight security on Friday and Saturday.

FOOD VENDOR RATES

ELECTRICITY IS NOT INCLUDED IN THE PRICE Vendors are charged **\$800 per 10' frontage for the 2-day event.** Food Vendors must provide their own electricity.
NO REFUND of Vendor fees are allowed for any reason.

APPLICATIONS AND ACCEPTANCE

Applications and full payment (check or money order only) must be returned by June 1st to receive priority consideration for participation. Applications and payments received after that date must be made by money order only and mailed directly to Irish Fair.

Applications will not be considered accepted until vendor receives acceptance from the Irish Fair Foundation, Inc.

NO REFUND OF VENDOR FEES IS ALLOWED FOR ANY REASON

CLEANING DEPOSIT

Food Vendor must include a cleaning/damage deposit check in the amount of \$150 made payable to IFF. It must be a separate check attached to a self-stamped and addressed envelope and must be included with your application. The same check probably will be refunded at the end of the Fair and surely within 30 days after the event if your area is left clean of all debris and free of damage. The cleaning deposit is not refundable unless it is paid by separate check along with self-addressed and stamped envelope.

SPECIAL 10% DISCOUNT IF PAYMENT MADE BY APRIL 10th
